Day 1 - SATURDAY, Feb 25 (In Israel) TEL AVIV-NAZARETH

Arrive in Tel Aviv 2:55 PM / Austrian Air 857 from Vienna

Just before Passport Control, be greeted by SMILE ASSISTANCE, then our guide Hussam and driver Drive north along the Mediterranean Seacoast to Nazareth.

Father will celebrate Holy Mass after we check into our hotel. Dinner. (TBA, possible Rosary procession, Basilica of the Annunciation / St. Joseph Church).

Day 2 - SUNDAY, Feb 26 NAZARETH-MT TABOR-CANA-NAZARETH

After breakfast. Walk across the street to the **Church of the Annunciation** to visit the Grotto where Mary 'heard The Word' and the upper parish church. After, visit the museum built over the village of Nazareth and learn about the many churches that have been built over the House of Mary. Stop at Joseph's Carpenter Shop. Walk through the town where Jesus grew up. Continue up to the Synagogue Church to read scripture and pray before walking to **Mary's Well** in the Greek Orthodox Church. Enjoy lunch.

In the afternoon drive to **Mount Tabor**. Transfer to taxis (Included) drive up to visit Antonio Barlucci's magnificent church. **Holy Mass 3:00 PM**. Here Jesus revealed His Glory in the Transfiguration.

Returning to Nazareth, (en route) visit to Wedding Church in Cana. Continue to Nazareth for dinner and overnight. After dinner, experience praying the Rosary in the Grotto

DAY 3 - MONDAY, Feb 27 NAZARETH - SEA OF GALILEE - NAZARETH

8:00 AM Holy Mass-Sanctary of Annunciation / Upper Basilica. After breakfast. Depart for the **Sea of Galilee** to visit Tabgha where Our Lord fed the 5,000 men with 2 loaves and 5 fishes. Continue to **The Primacy** where he asks Peter, "Do you love me?" (Confessions available) Next, travel to the **Mount of Beatitudes** where Jesus is believed to have delivered the Sermon on the Mount.

Stop to enjoy the Lunch of Saint Peter's fish (there's other choices if you don't care for fish).

In the afternoon, we will enjoy a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee. While on the boat there will be a short few minute, silent meditation. In the evening, transfer back to Nazareth, dinner and overnight in our hotel.

Day 4 - TUESDAY, Feb 28 NAZARETH - CAESAREA MARITIME - BETHLEHEM - JERUSALEM

After breakfast, drive to the Mediterranean Seacoast to visit Caesarea Maritime and visit of the ancient city, with the Roman theater and Crusader's fortress. Continue to the City of Bethlehem, the oldest Christian church in the world, built over the place where Our Lord was born, Church of the Nativity. followed by Lunch at the Franciscan Casa Nova

Afternoon. Holy Mass at Nativity/ Bethlehem. Time to shop in one of the Catholic stores before to continue to Jerusalem. Check in to our hotel in Jerusalem Old City, Franciscan Casa Nova. Dinner and overnight

Day 5 - WEDNESDAY, March 1 JERUSALEM - JERICHO - QUMRAN - DEAD SEA - JERUSALEM

AM HOLY MASS (TBA) in the Desert of Wadi Kelt. Drive South to the Judean Desert. Stop at the Jordan River, where Father will renew our Baptismal promises. Enter Palestine, and visit the old city of Jericho. See the Mount of Temptations and the excavations of the oldest city in the world. Stop at the Sycamore tree. Lunch. Transfer to the Dead Sea, and visit the excavation of Qumran, where the **Dead Sea Scrolls** were found. Enjoy floating in the **Dead Sea** (optional) the very lowest and saltiest waters of the world. Return to Jerusalem.

Day 6 - THURSDAY, March 2 JERUSALEM: OLD CITY - ST PETER IN GALLICANTU - MOUNT OF OLIVES

6:30 AM HOLY MASS, TOMB OF CHRIST. Visit the Holy Sepulchre

Depart Old City, visit the Western Wall and Temple Mount. We pass the closed Golden Gate as we leave and enter the Crusader church of St. Ann's and the Pools of Bethesda. Leave the city by St. Stephen's Gate. Continue to St. Peter in Gallicantu where our Lord was held by the high priest when he was arrested. After Lunch. We'll drive up on the **Mount of Olives** and walk down from the place of the **Ascension** to the Carmelite Convent where we remember Jesus teaching the Our Father. Continue down to Dominus Flevit where "He wept over the city". Moving on to the Garden of Gethsemane. Back to Hotel Jerusalem. Depart by bus the Bethlehem and enjoy a Middle East Feast Farewell dinner. Overnight

Day 7 - FRIDAY, March 3 JERUSALEM: OLD CITY - MOUNT SION

7:15 AM HOLY MASS, CALVARY. Holy Sepulchre.

Breakfast. Pray and walk the Via Dolorosa, (the actual Stations of the Cross) carrying a cross up through the Old City to the Church of the Holy Sepulcre. Stop on Calvary, and have an opportunity to enter the Tomb. Lunch. Continue to Visit Mount Sion Sanctuary of Cenacle and Dormition of Mary. Return to hotel. Dinner. Special Holy Hour overlooking the Holy City of Jerusalem.

9:00 PM - HOLY HOUR Franciscan Chapel Cave. Garden of Gethsemane overlooking the Holy City
